






PROGRAM IMPACT

The below data is a summary of the total impact and participation in the Baltimore Lab School Watershed Stewards Program through MWEE's and Action Projects



*41 BLS educators, 20 CBF educators, 4 MD Environmental Services and/or Port of Baltimore Environmental Specialist Staff, 2 NorthBay Adventures Staff

100% of BLS Students participated in the Watershed Stewards Program



HIGHLIGHTS

EDUCATION AND OUTREACH

- 15 Student-driven action projects
- 14 Meaningful Watershed Education experiences & outdoor trips

WILDLIFE & HABITAT:

- 26,000 Oyster spat planted on the Fort Carroll Oyster Sanctuary Reef in the Patapsco River
- 100 Indoor plants used to decorate Prom and then donated and living in every BLS classroom
- 20 Oyster cages filled with spat on shell, installed and maintained at the Oasis Marina in Baltimore City
- 10 Days gardening and maintaining our schoolyard habitat, the Ellen McDaniel Memorial garden and wildlife habitat
- 5 Baby terrapins visit with our Lower School students
- 1 Wolf adopted by our High School Students

STORMWATER:

- 200 Pounds of trash removed, including single-use plastics
- 24 Storm drains were cleaned, painted, and stenciled in our Old Goucher neighborhood
